Dear Mr. Harbuck:

<u>Louisiana R.S. 17:1808</u> requires all academic degree-granting institutions operating in the State of Louisiana to register with the Board of Regents (BoR) and be licensed <u>unless otherwise exempt</u>. Exemption from licensure is restricted to institutions named in law and <u>religious institutions</u> that grant religious degrees exclusively. The degrees must be religious in nature by title and content.

This letter is to notify you that our office has determined Evangel Christian University of America is exempt from licensure because it is an institution offering only religious degrees in the state of Louisiana. This exemption will only apply to postsecondary education.

Please note that although it was determined that Evangel Christian University of America is exempt from licensure for 2022, the institution is still required to register annually with the Board of Regents. You are also required to inform the Board of Regents of any changes that may occur in the religious status of your organization that could affect your institutions exemption from licensure.
